Mountain Collective Pass Discount

The <u>Mountain Collective</u> is a ski pass offering free and discounted ski days at selected resorts. The Calgary Ski Club has arranged for a discount code for the pass of the 2024/2025 ski season for SASC members.

Passholder benefits. Two free days each season at participating resorts and subsequent days at 1/2 price. If you buy early, you get a bonus free day at the resort of your choice. No blackout dates on lift tickets. There are additional perks such as hotel discounts and free Protect Our Winters (POW) membership. Hotels may have blackout dates.

Resorts in Western Canada on the Mountain Collective are Sunshine, Lake Louise, Panorama, Revelstoke, Sun Peaks and Marmot Basin. There are additional resorts in the USA, Europe, Chile, Australia, Japan, New Zealand and Australia. Active skiers should get excellent value out of this. See all <u>Resorts</u>.

Buy early for best deal. Get the best deal on a Mountain Collective pass by purchasing early. The price increases as sales reach certain levels and the bonus third day is no longer available after a certain number sales.

Member perk: Contact <u>Ken Gregory</u> and he will provide you with a discount code for \$91.00 USD off of the USD price at the time you buy. You may buy more than one pass with the discount code if they are on the same cart. Each pass will get the discount. You cannot use a code more than once and we are unable to provide you with more than one code.

Keep in mind, that after a certain number of passes are sold, the price will increase. Your code will be valid until the Mountain Collective ends sale of the passes in the fall and you may miss out on the bonus 3rd day.

Important: When you purchase the pass and get your confirmation, please keep the email with the bar code. You will need that to activate your pass at each hill. Every hill has slightly different procedures. Sunshine and Louise will give you a direct to lift pass which is good at either resort. Other resorts ask for your bar code to activate an RFID card. Some US hills may require you to reserve ski days in advance.

This is a summary only and while we believed is accurate; please refer to details about the passes on the <u>Mountain Collective</u> website. Note that after the two free days, the 1/2 price days at Sunshine and Louise are based on the <u>Big Three ticket</u> price.
